


SEPÚLVEDA/ADRIAZOLA



Adriazola / Sepúlveda, duo of filmmakers who have been working together for more than 10 years, immersed in the different realities of today's Chile. Known and praised by critics and the public as the most daring, interesting and controversial directors currently working in Chile. To date, they have made *El Pejesapo* (2007), *Mítomana* (2009), *El Destapador* (2012), *Crónica de un Comité* (2014), *Il Siciliano* (2017) and *Harley Queen* (2019). Films that have been part of festivals such as Locarno, San Sebastián, and BAFICI, among others. Retrospectives of their films have been dedicated to the duo in Peru (Transcinema), Spain (Malaga Festival), and France (Toulouse Festival). They are also founders of the FECISO (Social and Antisocial Film Festival), which has been taking place for 12 years with 23 versions, and also the first Popular Film School in Chile that has been running for 10 years.
